• THEA 420, Advanced Acting

This course develops and enhances the actor's skills and techniques through advanced analysis and performance of monologues, scenes, and improvisation. The course will focus on various period styles, performance methodologies, the audition process, the actor's process/approach, and critique.

## • THEA 220, Basic Acting for Majors and Non-Majors

Acting 220 is a beginning acting class designed to introduce students to the skills necessary to practice the craft of acting. Students will participate in various exercises designed to stimulate those creative processes through improvisation and solo and group exercises. Emphasis will be communication with other actors, stage movement, character/text analysis skills, playing an action, and performance.

## • THEA 110, Understanding Theater (Intro to Theater)

This class incorporates all elements of the art of theatre. We will talk about the aesthetics, origins, and development of theatre, as well as the social implications and practical processes involved in producing live theatre. Lecture, discussion, videos, and live theatre performances are used to bring students to an appreciation of the vital role theatre plays in society.

### • THEA 390, Playwriting

The course includes but may not be limited to; lecture, research (concrete and/or imaginative), creative exploration/process, writing exercises, viewing/reading assignments, and presentations. Students learn to write by writing. There will be writing exercises designed to help each student create/write a monologue, a one-minute play, a 10-minute play, and a one-act play for the Final Project. In class, some time will be spent writing and hearing each other's work. For parts of each class, except the last class, there will be a lecture about the elements of writing and helping students to think as a writer.

## • THEA 120, Acting I for Non Majors: Intro to Acting

Introduction to basic principles, theories, and techniques of acting: concentration, observation, relaxation, and objective. Students will learn basic character study with exploration of physical and vocal dynamics. The focus will be on the creation of the fundamental aspects of the craft of acting, an introduction to basic behavioral and imaginative skills, and the development of a practical method for creating simple belief and playing an action. Students will learn a rehearsal approach to developing a scene and a monologue. Moreover, they will be given a framework for observing the work of an actor by attendance at IU productions.

## • ENG 390, Playwriting for English Majors
